His Most Royal Excellency and Lord, Frederick Augustus¹, Duke of Saxony etc., Arch-Marshal of the Holy Roman Empire and Prince Elector etc., having most graciously instructed myself, Peter August von Schoenberg², Major-Domo, to arrange for the entire nameable furnishings and effects in the Prince Elector's Japanese Palace to be inventorised anew and accurately itemised, I duly commissioned Johann George Angern³, the Major-Domoship Secretary, to attend to the proper drafting of such an inventory, the latter successively putting this to effect as follows in the company of the bedmaster employed, Joseph Lechner⁴,

III. Japanese Porcelain.

Please note: this porcelain is marked with the cipher + throughout.

a) Garnitures and like bottles.

One large round 5-piece garniture comprising: 3 jars with covers surmounted by gilt openwork knops, 1 cubit 10 in. high, 18 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers, though these are damaged, 1 cubit 2 inches high, 13½ inches in diam. **No. 1.**

One 5-piece ditto comprising: 3 jars with covers surmounted by pointed gilt knops, 2 of the covers damaged, 1 cubit 10 in. high, 18 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers, one of which has suffered some damage, 1 cubit 2½ inches high and 13 inches in diam. **No. 2.**

One ditto 5-piece garniture. **No. 3.**

One ditto multifoil garniture of 3 jars and 2 beakers in the shape of upright bottles or urns. **No. 4.**

One round ditto consisting of 3 jars, one damaged; and 2 bottle beakers with handles. **No. 6.**

One ditto of 3 jars. **No. 7.**

One ditto garniture of 2 jars. **No. 10.**

Two large round jars with covers and pointed gilt knops, one of the jars and 2 covers damaged. **No. 11.**

One garniture consisting of 3 jars with gilt-knopped covers and 2 beakers. **No. 12.**

One like garniture consisting of 3 large and 2 smallish round jars with pointed knops on their covers. 1 cover in poor condition. **No. 13.**

with small blue knops on their covers, and 2 round beakers. **No. 14.**

One somewhat smaller ditto comprising 3 multifoil jars with covers and small gilt knops that are cemented on, 2 of the covers damaged, and two ditto beakers. **No. 15.**

One ditto round garniture, moulded with flowers in gilt, consisting of 3 jars with covers and pointed gilt knops; and 2 bottle beakers. **No. 16.**

One 5-piece round garniture comprising 3 jars and 2 beakers. 1 cover is broken. **No. 17.**

One ditto, 1 of the covers to which is damaged. **No. 19.**

One ditto 5-piece garniture with small blue knops on its covers. **No. 20.**

One ditto 5-piece garniture with small gilt knops on its covers. **No. 21.**

One ditto consisting of 2 large multifoil jarlets and 1 smaller one. The covers are surmounted by small cockerels instead of knops, 2 covers in poor condition; and 2 round bottle beakers. **No. 22.**

One garniture, moulded with flowers in gilt, comprising 3 jars with covers and small gilt knops and 2 beakers, one in poor condition. **No. 23.**

One like garniture consisting of same. **No. 24.**

One round openwork garniture, consisting of the above, the cover on 1 damaged. **No. 25.**

One multifoil 5-piece ditto, viz. 3 jars and 2 beakers. **No. 26.**

One 6-piece ditto comprising 4 jars and 2 beakers. 2 covers are damaged. **No. 27.**

One small round garniture, moulded with flowers in gilt, consisting of 3 jars and 2 beakers. 1 cover without a knop. **No. 28.**

One small round 3-piece garniture of 2 covered jars with round knops on top and 1 beaker. **No. 29.**

One ditto 3-piece garniture comprising 1 round jar and 2 flat-bulbed beakers. **No. 30.**

One garniture of 6 round bottles with long necks, 9 in. high, 4 inches broad. **No. 32.**

Two like bottles with long necks, 10 inches high, 4½ in. in diam. **No. 34.**

One bottle with a double belly, 11 inches high, 5 inches in diam. **No. 37.**

One bottle moulded with flowers, 7½ inches high, 5 inches in diam. **No. 38.**

Two bottles with ringed necks, 7 in. high, 3 inches broad. **No. 39.**

Two ditto with short necks, 5 inches high. **No. 40.**

Four small squat flasks with short necks, 3½ in. high and in diam. 1 in poor condition. **No. 41.**

One round 4-piece garniture, moulded with roses in gilt, consisting of 3 jars with short necks and round gilt-rimmed covers as well as ditto knops, 1 cubit 7½ inches high, 16 inches in diam.; and 1 like beaker, 23 inches high, 12 in. in diam. **No. 42.**

One ditto garniture of 3 jars with short necks and round openwork knops on their covers, 1 of which is damaged; and 2 beakers with gilt everted rims, 1 in poor condition. **No. 43.**

Four bottles with round bellies and long slender necks, 1 in poor condition, 10½ in. high, 4 in. in diam. **No. 46.**

Two jars with short wide necks and covers surmounted by small triple knops and 2 red handles, one of which is cemented on, 6 inches high. **No. 50.**

One hexagonal garniture of 3 jars with covers surmounted by gilt knops, 1 cubit 1 inch high, 13 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers with gilt everted rims, 17 inches high, 9 in. in diam. **No. 52.**

One small openwork ditto of 3 jars with solid inner walls, 6 in. high, 3½ in. in diam., 1 cover is missing; and 2 companion bottle beakers with short everted necks, 4½ in. high, 2 in. in diam. **No. 53.**

[fol. 7r] Six bottles with oval bellies and long necks, each sprigged with a blue dragon, 9½ inches high, 4½ in. in diam. **No. 54.**

Eighty-one small bottles and jarlets used as circular moulding in the rooms, 2¾ in. high. **No. 55.**

Two garnitures, each consisting of 3 oval covered jars with knops in blue and gilt, 1 cubit ½ inch high, 16 inches in diam.; and two companion beakers with flat-bulbed bellies, 22½ inches high, 10 inches in diam. **No. 56.**

[fol. 7v] One ditto of 3 oval jars with round covers surmounted by a gilt rabbit, 1 cubit 9 inches high; and 2 beakers with gilt everted rims, 1 cubit 1 inch high. **No. 57.**

One like garniture of 3 jars with pointed gilt knops on their covers, 1 cubit 13 inches high, 18 inches in diam.; and 2 companion beakers with gilt everted rims, 1 cubit 3 inches high and 12½ inches in diam. **No. 58.**

One ditto, the jars 12½ inches high, 8 inches in diam., the beakers 8¾ inches high, 4½ inches in diam. **No. 60.**

One garniture, moulded with flowers, of 3 jars with covers. The knops on these are missing, 10 in. high, 5½ inches in diam.; and 2 beakers, 7¾ in. high, 4½ inches in diam. **No. 62.**

One round, neatly pierced garniture, with a solid inner wall, consisting of 3 covered jars with pointed gilt knops, 10¾ inches high; and 2 bottle beakers, 8 in. high. 1 cover in poor condition. **No. 64.**

One garniture of 3 jars with covers surmounted by pointed gilt knops, 12 inches high; and two beakers, 8 inches high. **No. 65.**

One upright octagonal garniture consisting of 3 jars with moulded flowers and damaged covers surmounted by round knops in blue, and 2 like beakers. **No. 68.**

One bottle beaker, 10 inches high. **No. 69.**

Two beakers with gilt rims, 7 inches high. **No. 70.**

[fol. 9r]	Two like, 5¾ inches high. No. 71. One hexagonal garniture of 4 coverless jars moulded with florets, 5 inches high, 2½ inches in diam.; and 2 bottle beakers, 5 inches high, 2 inches in diam. No. 72. Two single jarlets without covers, 4 inches high. No. 73. One garniture of 3 small coverless jarlets, 4½ inches high. No. 74. One garniture of 3 covered jars with large pointed knops in gilt, 1½ cubits high, 18 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers with gilt rims, 1 cubit 1 inch high, 12 inches in diam. No. 77. Two oval jars with covers surmounted by pointed knops in enamels and gilt, 1 cubit 14 in. high. No. 78. One garniture of 3 covered jars surmounted by pointed knops in brown and gilt, 1 cubit 9 in. high; and 2 beakers, 1 cubit 1 inch high. No. 79. One garniture of 3 jars with covers surmounted by pointed blue knops, 1 cubit 3 inches high and 17 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers, 22 inches high. No. 80. One jar with a cover and pointed gilt knop, 1 cubit 5 inches high. No. 81. One ditto with a blue knop. No. 82. Two ditto with pointed gilt knops on their covers, 1 cubit 1 inch high. No. 83. One garniture of 3 covered jars with moulded flowers and gilt knops, 15½ inches high; and 2 like beakers, 11¼ inches high. No. 84.

One garniture consisting of 3 twin-bellied jars with flat covers surmounted by a small gilt lion instead of a knop, 10 inches high; and 2 like beakers, 8¼ in. high. 2 covers are damaged. **No. 85.**

One large garniture of 3 jars, neatly painted with copious birds, with grotesques on their covers, 1 cubit 14 in. high; and 2 beakers, 1 cubit 1 in. high. 1 cover is damaged. **No. 86.**

Two vases with covers upon which sit grotesques in polychrome and gilt, 1 cubit 15 inches high, 21 in. in diam. **No. 87.**

One particularly large garniture of 3 oval jars with covers and high hexagonal knops, 1 cemented on, 1 cubit 18½ inches high, 20½ in. in diam.; and two like beakers with gilt rims, 1 cubit 7½ inches high, 14½ inches in diam. **No. 90.**

One garniture of 3 oval jars having covers upon which sit gilt Indian cocks on mountains instead of knops, 1 cubit 12½ inches high and 12 inches in diam. **No. 91.** and 2 companion beakers with gilt rims, 1 cubit high, 12 inches in diam. *[inserted A:]* **91.**

One ditto garniture, painted with Indian birds and flowers in polychrome and gold, consisting of 3 jars with low, blue-knopped covers. The neck on 1 is damaged and 1 cover is missing, 12 inches high; and two beakers, 10½ inches high, 5 inches in diam. **No. 92.**

One octagonal ditto in old porcelain, consisting of 3 jars with covers and openwork knops, 1 no longer whole, 1 cubit 11½ inches high, 18 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers, 1 cubit high, 13½ inches in diam. **No. 93.**

One ditto garniture, with cartouches bordered by black lacquer that enclose flowers and cocks painted in colours, consisting of 3 jars with covers surmounted by mountains with wholly gilt grotesques, 1 cubit 15 inches high, 18 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers, 1 cubit 2 inches high and 12 inches in diam. **No. 94.**
1 beaker in poor condition.

One garniture of 3 jars with covers and pointed gilt knops, 1 cubit 6 inches high; and two like beakers, 23 in. high. **No. 95.**

Two single garniture jars with covers upon which sit grotesques in white and gold, 1 cubit 7 inches high. **No. 96.**

One hexagonal ewer, with a handle, cover and spout, painted with landscapes as well as with flowers and roses in polychrome and gold, 12 inches high, 7 inches in diam. **No. 99.**

One small hexagonal 5-piece garniture, painted with blue stripes and flowers in colours, comprising 3 jars with covers upon which blue grotesques sit, 11 inches high; and 2 companion beakers, 8½ inches high. **No. 100.**

One garniture, painted with moulded flowers and birds in poly-

[fol. 12v] chrome, comprising 3 small squat jars with covers, 10½ inches high, 4 inches broad; and two like beakers, 9 inches high, 4½ inches broad. 1 cover in poor condition. **No. 101.**

One 5-piece garniture, lightly moulded with flowers, comprising 3 jars with covers and small pointed knops, 9 inches high, 5 inches in diam.; and 2 companion beakers, each 8¾ inches high and 4 inches broad. 1 cover in poor condition. **No. 102.**

One 4-piece garniture, painted with landscapes, comprising 2 jars with covers and pointed knops, each 10½ in. high; and 2 like beakers, each 10 inches high. **No. 103.**

10¾ inches long. 1 item is in poor condition. **No. 116.**

One garniture of 3 large vases, painted with birds and flowers in colours, a gilt grotesque with a red ball squatting on their covers, 1 cubit 12 inches high, 17 inches in diam.; and two companion beakers, 1 cubit 1 inch high, 12 inches in diam. **No. 117.**

Two small garnitures, each of 5 pieces, viz. 3 jarlets with covers on which flowers are painted in gold and polychrome, 12½ in. high, 4¾ inches in diam.; and 2 companion beakers, 10 inches high, 3½ inches in diam. Some of the covers in poor condition. **No. 118.**

[fol. 14v] Two smaller ditto, 10 inches high and 4 inches in diam.; and 2 like beakers, 7¾ inches high, 3½ inches in diam. The jars are no longer whole. **No. 119.**

Two differinglly decorated garnitures, painted with flowers in gold and polychrome, each a set of 5 comprising 3 jars and 2 beakers. **No. 120.**

One small ditto garniture of 3 covered jarlets, painted with landscapes and flowers in colours, 12½ inches high; and two companion beakers, 10 inches high. 1 cover is missing. **No. 121.**

Two round ditto garniture jars in enamels with flat covers, 8 inches high, 7 inches in diam. **No. 122.**

[A: Are woven with cane.]

Four ditto bottles, 9 inches high, 6 inches in diam. The neck on 1 is in poor condition. **No. 123.**

Two large vases having short necks and covers surmounted by dark-blue knops, painted with flowers and roses in colours, 1 cubit 2 inches high,

Two openwork garnitures, each a set of 5 comprising: 3 jars with covers and pointed gilt knops, painted with birds and ornament, 11 inches high; and 2 like beakers, 8½ in. high. **No. 131.**

Three round bottle beakers with low bellies and high everted necks, painted with gold and flowers in polychrome, 10 inches high, 8½ inches in diam. **No. 132.**

One short-necked, 4-sided flask painted with birds and baskets of flowers, 9 inches high, 4 inches square. **No. 133.**

Two flat-backed scalloped flower jars painted with flowers in colours, 6 inches high, 2½ inches broad. **No. 134.**

One garniture jar with a cover upon which sits a gilt cock, painted with bouquets in gold and colours, 13 inches high, 7 in. in diam. **No. 135.**

Two ditto hexagonal garniture jars with covers and pointed knops, 9½ inches high, 5 inches in diam. **No. 136.**

Two round garniture beakers with slightly everted necks, painted with flowers and houses, 1 in poor condition, 8½ inches high, 3½ inches in diam. **No. 137.**

Two smaller ditto, 6½ inches high, 3½ inches in diam. **No. 138.**

Four 5-piece garniture sets, each comprising: 3 covered vases and 2 beakers, painted with Japanese flowers and gilt ornament. There are gilt grotesques on the covers along with birds and moulded ornament. The vases are 1 cubit 14 inches high, 17 inches in diam., and each beaker 1 cubit 1 inch high. The cover on one of the vases is damaged. **No. 139.**

Two 5-piece garniture sets in

[fol. 17r] old Japanese porcelain, each comprising: 3 vases with blue-knopped covers, 1 cubit 4 inches high, 16 inches in diam.; and 2 beakers, 21½ inches high, 12 inches in diam. Painted with polychrome flowers and partly gilded ornament throughout. One cover is damaged and the knop screwed on. **No. 140.**

One ditto set consisting of 3 covered vases and two beakers. There are grotesques on two of the covers and a small bird on the third, painted with flowers and ornament in colours, each vase 20 inches and each beaker 13 inches high. **No. 143.**

[fol. 17v] One small ditto garniture of 3 vases and 2 beakers, with small blue knops on their covers, painted with gilt ornament, each vase 9 inches high, 3½ in. in diam. The beakers, by contrast, are 7½ inches high, 4 inches in diam. **No. 144.**

Two garnitures, smaller again, each consisting of 3 vases, 7½ in. high, and 2 beakers, 6 inches high, painting as previous. 2 jars and 2 covers are in poor condition and one vase is damaged too. **No. 145.**

a *fontange* hairstyle, 1 cubit 3½ inches high. **No. 3.**

Four men made of lead, with long black beards and caps that can be
removed, standing on pedestals, down by their feet a fountain, 19 inches
high. **No. 6.**

Four like figures made of wood but without fountains. **No. 7.**

Three females in their attire and with combs in their hair, 2 of the combs
in poor condition however, 19 inches high. **No. 8.**

Three like figures, 16 inches high. **No. 9.**

Ten like figures, 4 of whom have one child on their arms and two
children standing by their feet. The heads are missing on two children,
much else is damaged besides, 16½ inches high. **No. 10.**

Eleven like females, 1 of whom has 1 child on her arms and 2 by her feet.
1 is holding a child on her arms and 1 has one standing by her feet. The

ve no children, <have> 15 and 16 in. high. Mostly damaged. **No. 11.**

Three like figures with children on their arms and also at their feet in

Two like figures, 9 inches high. **No. 15.**

Two pedestals, each with 4 Indian men at a small table on which there is food, a dog and a monkey beneath, 7 inches high. **No. 17.**

Two pedestals, two children on each, 7 inches high. Damaged. **No. 18.**

Two seated pagods, 6 in. high. **No. 19.**

Four ditto, 6½ inches high. Damaged. **No. 20.**

Three small dolls with children, one broken off, 7 inches high. **No. 21.**

Five like dolls with children on their arms, 6½ inches high. 2 are in poor condition. **No. 22.**

One ditto, with a rabbit below, 7 inches high. **No. 23.**

Six white parrots with wings in red and gilt, 10 in. high. The beak on one is in poor condition, and 2 are in very poor condition. **No. 24.**

Four small white oxen with patches of red, 4 inches high, 6 inches long. In poor condition. **No. 25.**

[fol. 23r]

Two seated white dogs with patches of red and black, 6 inches high. Damaged. **No. 26.**

Two large seated pagods with weights on head and hands, in wood and Saxon porcelain. They nod their heads, wiggle their hands and poke out their tongues, 13 inches high, 16 inches broad. **No. 28.**

One white mountain, populated with copious small pagods and animals, 12 in. high, 9 inches in diam. **No. 31.**

Four like items, on each of which two small pagods stand at a table on a pedestal, a small pagod crouching below, 6 inches high, 5 inches in diam. **No. 32.**
